Questionnaire for Determining Behavioral Health Insurance Benefits

Please note that we are only considered in-network with CareFirst BCBS PPO, Magellan BCBS Blue Choice HMO, and TriCare Prime and Standard. If one of these is your secondary insurance only and your primary insurance is not on this list, your treatment will not be covered fully. Please call your health insurance carrier to answer these questions before attending the first session:

Is Quince Orchard Psychotherapy/Dr. Carrie Singer a participating provider with my plan? (If they ask, our National Provider Identification (NPI) number is 1730417395).

Are you the administrator of my mental health benefits? (Many plans have separate phone lines for medical and behavioral health and if you reach the medical line, they may give you incorrect information).

Is pre-authorization needed? What does that entail?

Do I have a deductible to meet? How much is it? When does my deductible reset?

Is there a limit on how many sessions will be covered per calendar year?

What is my copay? Is it the specialist or primary care copay designation? If I have a co-insurance (percentage), what is the allowed amount for the service code (see below) this percentage will be based on?

If they need to know the procedure codes we will be using, they are:

- 90791 (Diagnostic Interview, the first two sessions)
- 90834 (45-minute psychotherapy session)
- 90837 (60-minute psychotherapy session)
- 96101 (per hour of psychological testing for administration, scoring, and report writing)

If this is for psychological testing, are there any diagnoses that are not covered (Learning Disabilities, etc.?)
